



# KORE OVERVIEW



## **SUSTAINABLE SOLUTIONS TO EXTREME POVERTY IN HAITI.**

Haiti is close to the United States, yet it remains the poorest country in the Western Hemisphere. The goal of the KORE Foundation is to go “Beyond Relief” focusing on treating the underlying cause of the problem, not just the symptom.

KORE’s approach is to create business opportunities in agricultural development to promote food security, education, economic development & community health in Haiti. Our main objective in all of this is to share the hope of the gospel.

## HOPE FOR TODAY

KORE addresses the immediate needs of malnourished children by adding chicken to their diets. The poultry is purchased from KORE small holder farmers. This focused approach helps farmers with their business while meeting a need for hungry children.

## HOPE FOR TOMORROW

KORE provides a small business loan to a family or individual to start a chicken coop business. On average, this increases their annual income 4-6 times in the first year.

## HOPE FOR ETERNITY

Our staff directs discipleship training for small holder families and responds to opportunities to present the Gospel message through community relationships. Additionally, KORE ministers to children in the 6.25 Feeding Program with the help of Impact Teams.

It's a great fundraising opportunity, as well as a chance to talk more about Haiti's culture.


